Billings Family Educational Fund for Women

This is a fund established for women students seeking to attend a training school, college, or university to learn a new skill or trade in order to have a new start and direction in life. This is a one-year scholarship renewable for up to three years. At this time two \$1,000 scholarships are available.

Criteria and Guidelines for the Billings Family Educational Fund for Women Scholarship

- 1. The applicant must be female.
- 2. The applicant must currently live in McPherson County.
- 3. The applicant must be a student at least 20 years of age not having attended school within the last school year.
- 4. The applicant must describe how gaining educational training will enable her to overcome a difficult life situation.
- 5. The applicant must describe how this educational training is compatible with her interests and abilities and will further her personal goals for a new direction in life.
- 6. The applicant must provide detailed information about the program she wishes to enter.
- 7. The applicant will submit two written recommendations along with the application.
- 8. The recipient of the scholarship will need to submit a renewal application in order to extend the scholarship for an additional year.
