

WACCC HISTORY

Avon's partnership with the National Main Street Organization was designed to raise awareness of breast cancer through Pink Line Walks in communities throughout the country. McPherson residents participated in the Pink Line Walk and the Pink Pajama Party to inform women of preventative measures and hear stories from local women fighting the disease.

Since then, the initiative has evolved from a marketing effort to a grass roots effort in providing funds locally. In 2005, an endowment fund was established with the McPherson County Community Foundation to build a permanent resource for women and children. Grants are given to assist with medical expenses, pharmaceutical costs, transportation, nutritional expenses or household needs. Any McPherson County woman or child is eligible to receive a grant.

COMBAT BAGS

The Combat Bag program was established in 2009 as an outreach to not only the patient, but the family as well. The Combat Bag is filled with comfort items and supplies that meet the needs of each individual family. Items placed in previous bags include:

Gift cards for fuel, food and clothing, Coloring supplies, stuffed animals, blankets, lotions, movie rental certificates, magazines, books, dental hygiene kits, toys, rice bags, water filters, scarf's, hats and much more!

Once an applicant has applied for a grant, they are contacted to see if there are needs for the family. Items are provided by donations from McPherson County businesses and individuals. WACCC recently received a grant made available through the Larry Wedel Health Fund, administered by the McPherson County Community Foundation. The bags are given to women and children as they go through treatments and recovery.
